  - 4) Examine the theme of loneliness as presented by Anita Desai, against the background of the city of Calcutta, in *Voices in the City*. (1×8=8)
- III. Answer any four of the following in about 80 words each:
  - 5) The nostalgic view of India from the narrator's point of view in "India-A Fable".
  - 6) The contemporary society as depicted in R. K. Narayan's story.
  - 7) The theme of Aurobindo's sonnet "The Stone Goddess".
  - 8) The element of irony and satire in Ezekiel's poem.
  - 9) The central theme of the poem "Taj Mahal".
  - The unexpected end to the experiments carried out by the couple in Manjula Padmanabhan's story. (4×4=16)

  - 12) Comment on the closing lines of Ramanujan's poem "The Last of the Princess".
  - 13) Comment on he use of allegory and symbolism in Gopal Honnegere's poem.
  - 14) What do the epitaph on the tombstones tell the reader about the dead who lie buried beneath them in Mahapatra's poem?
  - 15) What is the railway clerk's only consolation?
  - 16) Explain the beauty of the line "to clutch the cross like a desired wife".
  - 17) What made the narrator a devoted follower of Labhu and what all things did he teach the narrator?
  - Comment on the attitude of the newcomer towards the caste system in R. K. Narayan's story.
  - 19) What jewellery has the wife of the last prince inherited?
  - 20) Explain the poetic device used by Parthasarathy in the lines "... But this marble flame/Earth's other moon...". (3×1=8)
